
European 450mm Equipment & Materials Initiative: EEMI 450



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Long-term Objective of the Initiative

- To improve the competitiveness of the European semiconductor E&M industry and therefore increase the chances to be selected by the tier 1 semiconductor companies in their future 450mm operations.
- To stimulate a European infrastructure that is leading in 450mm development and as a result will induce tier 1 companies to cooperation programs and possibly equip 450mm fabs in Europe.

EEMI 450 Steering Committee

- Create a communion/network of E&M companies which work on 450mm topics
- Voluntary membership, no fees
- General assembly 2x year
- General assembly will choose SC members

Objectives EEMI 450

- Increased cooperation between member companies on common technologies:
 - Decrease R&D efforts
 - Decrease development timeframe
 - Optimise equipment specifications/performance

Examples:

- Standards/specifications
- 450mm wafer characterisation
- Wafer handling/cold/hot
- Loadports/Platforms
- Automation/Logistics
- Software



Objectives EEMI 450 (2)

Cooperation with leading institutes:

- Early availability of metrology equipment, which can be utilised by the members
- Evaluation of α- and β-systems
- Cooperation with material suppliers
 - Early availability of testwafers and other materials

Communication

- Link with ISMI
- Involvement of tier 1 companies
- 450mm activities/initiatives outside EU
 - Align Roadmaps
 - Common Standards
 - Possible cooperations



Near Term Activities

- Organizing General Assembly
- Defining working groups having common development interests (horizontal & vertical)
- Working groups define common projects
- European support programs could be used
 - ENIAC call 2
 - Catrene call 2
 - FP7 ICT call 5
